Dear Parish Family,
One of the least understood and perhaps most misunderstood teaching of the church is the teaching on indulgences. According to the

Catechism of the Catholic Church: "The doctrine and practice of indulgences in the Church is closely linked to the effects of the Sacrament of Penance." "An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian, who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the Saints." "An indulgence is partial or plenary according as it removes either a part or all of the temporal punishment due to sin. The faithful can gain indulgences for themselves or apply them to the dead." (CCC 1471) Since the faithful departed now being purified (in the state called Purgatory) are also members of the same communion of saints, one way to help them is to obtain indulgences for them, so that the temporal punishments due to their sins may be remitted." (CCC1479) As we remember All Souls this month, and approach our Parish Mass of Remembrance, it is good to remember that there are many ways we can help our departed loved ones on their way to Heaven.
