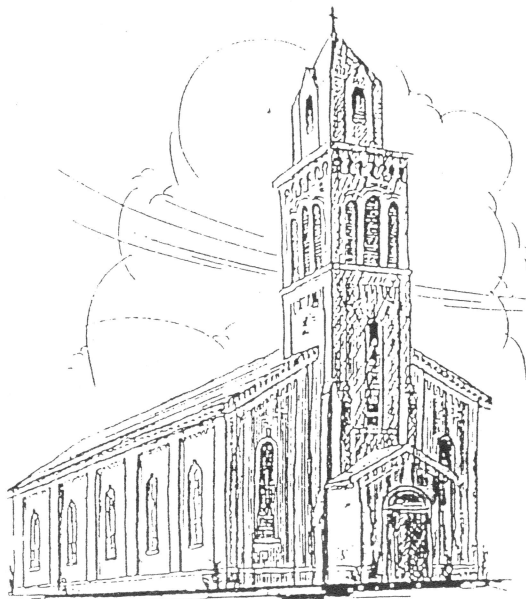

The Seven Sacraments (Eucharist)

The Eucharist has been proclaimed to be many things: it is the pinnacle of our Sacramental life, a Sacrament of Initiation, Healing and Mission/Commission. The Eucharist (the word itself means thanksgiving) is the perfect prayer of praise to our heavenly Father in union with Jesus Christ empowered by the Holy Spirit. At Mass, through the Ministry of the Priest by the Power of the Holy Spirit, the Bread and Wine become actually, literally and completely, the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ; the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity. The Eucharist is not just a memorial of Jesus, nor is it a sign of Jesus, nor a fellowship meal; it is truly the Real Presence of Jesus Christ. The Eucharist is not a holy thing or object; it is the Divine Person of our Lord Jesus Christ truly present in the Sacramental sign until He comes again in glory. The Mass is a re-enactment in an unbloody way the Sacrifice on the Cross, it is also a Banquet for the People of God as a foretaste of the Banquet in Heaven. When we receive Communion and say Amen; we are saying that we believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and are one with the practice and teaching of the Catholic Church.
