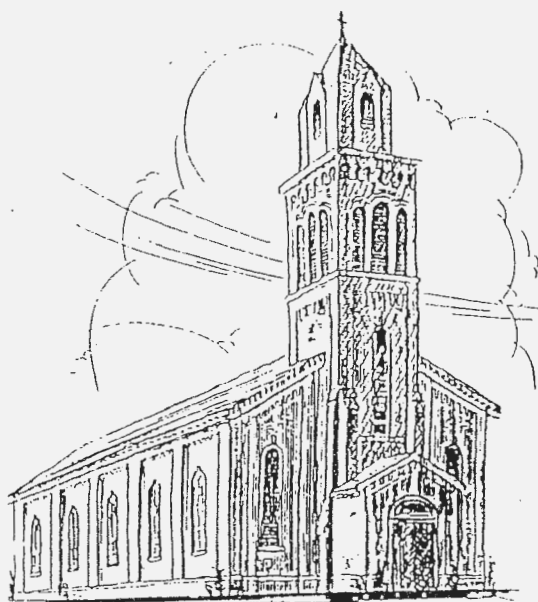

### **Altar Server Ministry Training**

Dear Children, I would like to invite you to consider becoming an Altar Server at St. Francis Xavier Parish. The ministry of Altar Server is an important ministry and part of our celebration of the Eucharist every Sunday at Mass. Like all calls to serve God's people, it is God who really invites you to be a server. The server is the priest and deacon's right hand helper. Thank you for thinking about being an Altar Server. ## Faith Formation

## The Seven Sacraments (Baptism)

The first Sacrament that we receive to begin our life of grace is Baptism. The symbols we use in this sacrament speak profoundly of what we profess. First, is the naming of the one to be Baptized. This naming is an acknowledgement of a new relationship with God and His people. The one to be baptized is then signed with the cross on the forehead, claiming the person for Christ; there is an anointing with the Oil of Catechumen asking for the strength to live the faith and then the proclamation of the Word of God. We then invoke the Saints in a litany (we are a member of the entire community of God). After this is the renunciation of Sin and Satan and the profession of faith. Then there is the Blessing of the water asking God to unseal the Font of Baptism for His people. The person is then Baptized: in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit as water is poured three times over their head; we move to the anointing the crown of the head with Sacred Chrism (the oil used at Confirmation and for Holy Orders), clothing with a white garment (symbolic of the New Life in Christ) an lighted candle, from the Paschal (Easter Candle) and the blessing of the ears and mouth asking that God will coach the ears to receive His truth and the mouth to proclaim the faith. We conclude with a communal reciting of the Lord's prayer and blessing ending with the Alleluia. The effects of Baptism are powerful: original sin is removed (and in the case of an adult, all previous personal sin as well), the person becomes a Child of the Father, a sibling of Christ and a member of God's Holy People; taking on the threefold mission of Prophet, Priest and King in sharing the life and mission of Jesus Christ.
