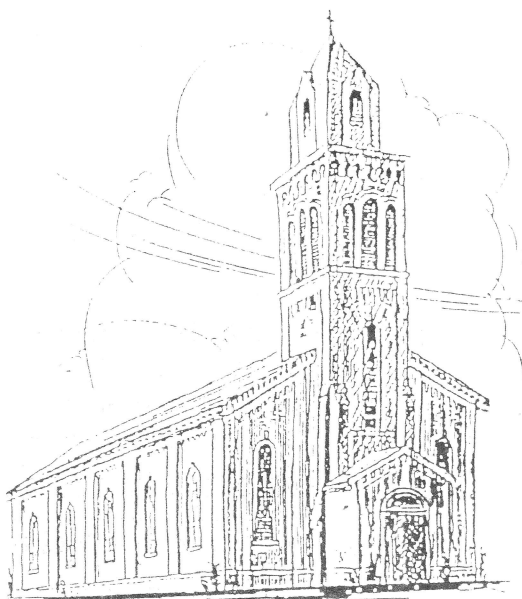

This week we conclude our reflection on Cardinal Dulles' Six Models of the Church.  
5. Institution: This model reminds

us that the Church has a visible, organizational structure and order. The Church is a hierarchical institution instituted by Christ to serve the people of God and proclaim the Good News of the Gospel. The Pope, as the Vicar of Christ on earth, in his office as Supreme Pontiff enjoys universal jurisdiction and magisterium, included in this is the Charism of Infallibility. This model provides clear roles and guidelines for living.

6. Community of Disciples: We are reminded that we are a community of disciples, gifted with the Holy Spirit, trying to be like Jesus in everything we do, say and how we pray. It also reminds us that our discipleship may also include suffering for our faith. We have a strong connection with Jesus and personal accountability, but we are always a member of the community, which is the Church.
