Dear Parish Family, As we approach the 60th anniversary of Vatican II, I thought that it would be good to re-visit and actually

good to re-visit and actually understand what the Council did and

said. I will begin with a look at the work by the late Cardinal Avery Dulles entitled <u>The Models of the Church</u>. In this book Cardinal Dulles describes the Church in light of the models set forth in the Council. The Models are: 1. Mystical Communion, 2. Sacrament, 3. Servant, 4. Herald, 5. Institution and 6. Community of Disciples. For the next few weeks we will look at these models.

Mystical Communion this Model reminds us that we are bound together as a family of faith not by race, or ethnicity or language but by something much stronger; that is the Holy Spirit who at our Baptism makes each of us a child of the Father, a sibling of Jesus and a member of the Mystical Body of Christ as described by St. Paul in both Corinthians and Romans. While the Church is to be a welcoming community, it is not just another social or service organization or club, not just friendly fellowship but truly a Mystical Communion in the Body of Christ.

Sacrament (sometimes called the Universal Sacrament of Salvation): the church is the visible sign of the Redemptive and Saving action of Jesus Christ in the world today through the Seven Sacraments instituted by Christ to give grace to the individual, the community and the world. We are reminded that the Church is human (made up of we who are sinners) it is also Divine, empowered always and everywhere by the Holy Spirit. The Church exists not only for itself or her members; but to proclaim and bring Jesus Christ and His saving grace to the whole world.
