Dear Parish Family,

On November 2, the priests and deacons of our Diocese had the opportunity to gather with our Bishop for a presentation given by

Msgr. Stephen J. Rossetti. Msgr. Rosetti is a priest of our Diocese (and a native or Marcellus) who is currently exercising his ministry as an exorcist in the Archdiocese of Washington, and is the author of the book: Diary of an American Exorcist: Demons, Possession, and the Modern-Day Battle against an Ancient Evil. This is not about Halloween, horror, or scary movies; or some superstition for a bygone time when people were supposedly 'less' sophisticated or 'less' educated than today. It is about the reality that there is a spiritual warfare going on today between the demonic (Satan) and the forces of good (God, the angels, saints, and the Church). The final outcome is not in doubt: God is God; Satan and the demons are but creatures who are as dust before God's power. The victory is won, the Kingdom of God is at hand and assured. Jesus Christ has conquered sin and death and overcome the powers of darkness once and for all. Yet in his pride, Satan and the demonic are still waging war against the Kingdom of God and His Church, and will do so until the victorious return of Christ. How is this struggle evident? Look at the rise of hatred, discord and violence; the number of people who have turned from the faith, the attacks against the Church, the continuing disregard for the sacred gift of human life. So, what should we do? Avoid all types of occult practices: Ouija boards, tarot cards, fortune tellers, astrology, mediums and the like: all forms of Divination are called in the Bible, an abomination before God. Positively, stay close to the Church and regular practice of the Sacraments; especially Confession and Eucharist. Pray together as a family, especially the Rosary (the Blessed Mother, Mary, is particularly hated by Satan and the demonic), have a blessed Crucifix in your home, use sacramentals: Holy Water, Scapulars, Blessed medals and Blessed images of the Saints. Most importantly, never fear or despair: Jesus Christ is Our Savior and Our Hope and the ultimate victory belongs to Him, and we, because of our Baptism, belong to God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in Heaven.

I would also like to say "Thank You" and "God Bless" to our Veterans: Living and Deceased.
