

St. Francis Xavier's Spiritual Adoption Update: 7 Months and still growing every day. Thank you for your continued prayers for our Preborn babies, their mothers, their fathers and all who support these people. Prayers work miracles and your prayers will have been answered. God listens to our prayers. He hears the heartbeats of His new creations. Our spiritually adopted babies are 14-17 inches in length and weight about 4 1/2 pounds. "I have been fully formed since 8 week but needed to gain weight. It's nearing time for arrival. Mom is getting uncomfortable with my size". Mothers may need help in getting ready for her baby's arrival. It hasn't been easy but your prayers have helped her. She knows that there are places and people to assist her. A couple of places that can help would be Birthright Pregnancy Center and Joseph's House. She may have chosen to have others parent her child. Lord, we pray for every little child living in the womb and especially those unborn babies we have adopted that they might grow in the image and likeness of the God who made them . Amen



With **Advent** we begin another liturgical year, another year of grace. There is a singular beauty to Advent in the church, it invites us to calm down and remove ourselves from the hectic

pace in our preparation to celebrate Christmas, although it is good and necessary to prepare for Christmas, Advent invites us to prepare spiritually for the coming of Christ. If we pay attention we see the sights and sounds of Advent in the liturgy sets the scene for quiet reflection; there is no Gloria at Mass, the music is more subdued and the liturgical color is violet. The Advent wreath is the visible reminder of the waiting in expectation for the coming of Jesus, as the 'light of the world'.

I would like to offer some suggestions as how each of us can prepare spiritually during Advent. Have a family Advent Wreath and light it together each evening with the appropriate prayers; think about attending our Advent Parish Mission; use the Advent books that are provided with daily reflections and activities; and make a special effort to bring the entire family to Confession before celebrating the birth of Christ. However you and your family choose to celebrate Advent, ember: "Come, Lord Jesus" is our hope, not only for Advent and Christmas, but for our entire life's journey. God Bless, Fr. Dan

UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE NORTHERN DISTRICT OF NEW YORK

In re The Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse, New York Case No. 20-30663 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT, On June 19, 2020, The Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse, New York, ("Diocese") filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"). The Court has established January 17, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) (the "Supplemental Bar Date") as the deadline to assert claims against the Diocese arising from or relating to abuse that occurred when the survivor was 18 years of age or older, and which, prior to the enactment of the Adult Survivors Act (S.66A/A.648A) would have been subject to a statute of limitations defense ("Adult Claims"). If you have an Adult Claim against the Diocese you must file a claim on or before the Supplemental Bar Date, which will be treated confidentially in accordance with prior court orders Case. Please https://case.stretto.com/dioceseofsyracuse for call (855)329-4244 for more info. on how to file your proof of claim.
