The Seven Sacraments (Matrimony)

Matrimony is one of the Sacraments of Mission/Comission as it continues God's creative loving activity in our world. Marriage is a unique Sacrament in the way it is celebrated in New York State, the civil and Sacramental aspects are put together in one celebration. Civilly, the couple gets a marriage license prior to the Church celebration which is signed after the ceremony by the best man and maid of honor and the officiant (Priest/Deacon). Sacramentally, Matrimony is unique in that the man and woman administer the Sacrament to each other with the officiant receiving the consent on behalf of the Church.

THE RITE OF MATRIMONY INVOLVES:

Questions before the Consent

Have you come here to enter into Marriage without coercion, freely and wholeheartedly? Are you prepared, as you follow the path of marriage, to love and honor each other as long as you both shall live? Are you prepared to accept children lovingly from God to bring them up according to the law of Christ and His Church? To each of these questions, both must respond in the affirmative.

The Consent (Marriage Vows)

The Bride and Groom take turns sharing their vows. I promise to be faithful to you, in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health,

I will love you and honor you all the days of my life. Reception of Consent

The officiant then says:

May the Lord in his kindness strengthen the consent you have declared before the Church, and graciously bring to fulfillment his blessing within you.

What God joins, together, let no one put asunder. (These are taken from the Order of Celebrating Matrimony)

At this point the couple are Sacramentally married and will administer the grace of this Sacrament to one another and to the Church for the rest of their lives.
