Gospels for the celebration give us a complete answer. In Matthew 1:1-25 we are given the genealogy of Jesus: son of David, the son of Abraham recalling for us that Jesus is completely human with a family history and a family tree. Luke 2:1-14 (the most well known of the Christmas Gospels) and Luke 2:15-20 gives us the story of Jesus' birth in Bethlehem and here we hear of the Angels and Shepherds; truly a remarkable birth!
