The "Marks" of the Church

Dear Parish Family,

Traditionally we talk about the 'marks' of the Church as being: One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic. This is what we mean.

The Church is One: that is it has a unity of faith, worship and teaching. Although it is made up of many members with different gifts, all the members and all the gifts are given by the Holy Spirit for the common good and the proclamation of the Gospel. The Church is under One Leader, the Holy Father who is the successor of St. Peter and the Vicar of Christ on Earth.

The Church is Holy: Each of us as individual humans are capable of sin, the Church, the Body of Christ is Christ's spotless bride. The holiness of the Church comes from the activity of the Holy Spirit in and through the members of the Church and in a very particular way the gift of the Seven Sacraments.

The Church is Catholic: that is the church is universal. The Church can be found in every culture, society and land; with her faith and truth expressed in every human language. You can travel anywhere and the Mass and celebration of the Sacraments will follow the same rite and rituals with each Diocese led by the Bishop and all of us in union with the Holy Sea.

The Church is Apostolic: we trace the life of the Church back through 21 centuries to Pentecost, where the Apostles first receive the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and were confirmed in the mission given to the by Christ to go out to all the world and proclaim the good news, there is an unbroken chain of faith and teaching from Francis back through time to Peter and ultimately to Christ.
