The Catholic Church's Long Tradition of Protecting All Life

Last Sunday we had a holy hour here at St. Francis Xavier where we prayed and reflected on the gift of life.

Monday (1/23) the Church celebrated a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children, that was also the day the Church celebrated the memorials of St. Vincent and St. Maryanne Cope; on Tuesday we celebrated the memorial of St. Francis de Sales. Through our history the Catholic Church has protected the dignity of all human life. A document from the first century called the 'Didache' proclaims; "Thou shalt not kill a fetus by abortion". Our saints have reminded us how we are to care for human life at all stages from conception to natural death. St. Vincent dedicated his life to care for the poor; Maryanne Cope took care of lepers who were social outcasts; St. Francis de Sales was devoted to charity and the education of the young. From our earliest days, the Church has built hospices, hospitals and schools; caring for the very young and the elderly with love and compassion; reminding us that all human life, no matter what stage of development, social or economic condition, race, creed or even condition is a valuable gift from God with an inherent dignity, worthy of our protection and respect. From the Spiritual Renewal Center: Self-Compassion: Science and Spiritual Practice Thursday, February 2 | 7:00 pm EST (virtual only) Presented by Rev. Dr. Steve Moore Fee: \$25, or whatever you can afford Compassion is the cornerstone of most spiritual traditions. At the same time, psychological research has found that compassion is essential for a healthy life. Yet, for most of us, self-compassion is elusive. We are caught in unhelpful and destructive thought loops that lead to self-judgment and unhappiness. Spend some time learning about the science of self-compassion and learn helpful techniques that help you develop the subtle art of self-compassion.

The Rev. Dr. Steven Moore is the director of the Spiritual Renewal Center, an Episcopal priest and licensed clinical psychologist. He is currently finishing a doctor of ministry at Colgate Rochester Crozier Divinity School and has focused his research on applying the prophetic tradition and liberation theology to our modern context.
