

Lenten Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence

Days of Abstinence: No meat can be eaten on Ash Wednesday and all of the Fridays during Lent. This applies to all Catholics 14 and older.

Days to Fast: Only one full meal is permitted on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for Catholics between 18 and 59. Two smaller meals are permitted, but the small meals should not equal a second full meal. Drinking coffee, tea and water between meals is allowed. Snacks between meals are not allowed.

One is not bound to fast if health or the ability to work is affected.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.)

Lent is "a period of more intense spiritual preparation, consisting more in interior reflection than in

catechetical instruction, and is intended to purify the minds and hearts of the elect as they search their own consciences and do penance. This period is intended as well to enlighten their minds and hearts with a deeper knowledge of Christ the Savior. The celebration of certain rites, particularly the scrutinies and the presentations brings about this process of purification and enlightenment and extends it over the course of the entire Lenten season" (R.C.I.A., 139).

The Rite of Election will be celebrated by Bishop Lucia at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception on the First Sunday of Lent (February 26th) at 2:30 PM.

Meeting Christ in Prayer IS BACK!

After a 3 year break due to covid, we are elated to bring back this incredible 8 week prayer experience this Lenten and Easter season. Modeled after the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola, Meeting Christ in Prayer introduces participants to various ways of praying, helps them form regular habits of prayer, and provides them with an opportunity to meet Christ anew. Participants take part in a retreat within their daily lives, during which they commit to 20 - 30 minutes of daily prayer and reflection exercises. Throughout the retreat, you are supported with eight weekly small group meetings that include group prayer, guided meditation, faith sharing, and reflection; and an overview of prayer exercises that are practiced throughout the week.
