Dear Parish Family, As we get ready for Lent (Ash Wednesday is March 5), I thought that a

reflection on heaven would be appropriate. Usually when people think of heaven they envision a place of clouds, where angels are floating around singing on harps, with the Saints praising God who is sitting on His throne. Heaven is not a reward for good living, God does not keep a scorecard where at the end of our biological life if we are the plus we win heaven, if we are in the negative we lose heaven for hell. Humans do not become angels in heaven. Humans are created in the Divine image and likeness, have a unique and personal relationship with God; where we enjoyed God's friendship and presence. Sin disrupts or destroys this relationship and the image of God in each of us given originally. Baptism and the grace of God restores that relationship and image, however, personal sin throughout our life distorts, and in the case of mortal sin, destroys that image and relationship. By the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus, we have the ability to be redeemed, our relationship with God restored and eternal life given. We have a choice, choose God, God's way, God's Life and God's Kingdom or choose to reject God, His way, life and Kingdom. The first is Heaven, the Second is Hell; but the choice is ours.
