

### Why Lent?

Dear Parish Family, Each year we enter into a forty day preparation for Easter, but the question arises: "Why Lent?" "What is

the purpose of Lent?" This week's Gospel for the second Sunday of Lent of the Transfiguration gives some insight in answering these questions. In the Transfiguration, Jesus lets His Divinity be seen to Peter, James and John. This experience along with Moses and Elijah (symbolizing the Law and the Prophets) gives witness and testimony to the same reality that was given at Jesus' Baptism.. The Spirit and Father testify to Jesus as the beloved Son in whom the Father is well pleased. We became God's children, by Sanctifying Grace, at our Baptism; clothed with a white garment, we were reminded of our new dignity, a dignity that we are to keep untarnished unto Eternal Life. Unfortunately, because of our sin, that dignity gets tarnished, and even totally obscured. Lent provides us the occasion to allow God's grace, once again to restore our dignity and remove our sins through our Penance Prayer, Fasting and Alms-Giving and in a very singular way through the Sacrament of Confession. Unlike Jesus' Transfiguration, this is an interior, spiritual transfiguration for us. This interior transfiguration should not be limited to external acts of piety (remember the Pharisees whom Jesus called: "Whited Sepulcher", whose intention was rotted and who acted for show, so that others would think that they were holy. For us, this interior transformation must be evident in the way we live our daily lives, not just in prayer or in church, but in each moment and every word and action, we should show ourselves to truly be, by God's grace, our Father's children.
