Why Catholics do some of the things we do?

Friday, February 3^{rd} is the feast of St. Blaise, a day when we traditionally bless throats using the prayer:

"Through the intercession of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, may God free you from every disease of the throat and all other ailments. In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." Many non-Catholics, and Catholics do not really understand why the Catholic Church has such practices. First, we DO NOT worship the Saints, we venerate and respect them as examples of those who have gone before us and have achieved the goal of all human life, Eternal Happiness in Heaven with our God. We do profess in the Creed our belief in the Communion of Saints. Our belief that those in Heaven are part of our faith family, and as such, have desire for all of us to join them in the Kingdom of our God; thus they intercede for us and assist us with their prayers.

Also, the use of Rituals and Rites that have physical expression (such as Holy Water, Incense, Music, Statues, Music, and Candles) and are tangible, physical expressions of our faith and remind us that we use all of our faculties and senses in our prayer, worship, and relationship with God.
