

Look around our Church

Dear Parish Family, As you look around our Church you see the beautiful stainedglass windows down the sides depicting the

life of Jesus with the Crucifixion directly over the Tabernacle. The statue of the Sacred Heart of Jesus greets you as you come in the front entrance; with the statues of the Blessed Mother and St. Joseph on either side of the Tabernacle (the place where the Holy Eucharist is kept). As you are facing the Altar, to the left is the Ambry where the Holy Oils are kept (these will be replaced after the Chrism Mass during Holy Week). There is the Altar, Baptismal Fount, and Lectern; what is missing during Lent is the Paschal Candle (it is bought out for Funerals and Baptisms); a new one will be blessed and processed into the church during the Easter Vigil. Also missing during Lent is Holy Water in the founts at the Church entrances; blessing one-self with Holy Water is a sign of the 'Pre-Sanctified'; those who have been Baptized into the faith community; again, during the Easter Vigil, new water will be blessed and the founts re-filled. One of the most beautiful appointments to our Church is the community of faithful gathered in prayer. We are truly a mosaic of the people of God: there are babies, little children, young children adolescents, young adults, married couples, families, single people, and those of us who are not so young. Each is important, each has a gift to offer, and together we make up the Mystical Body of Christ: the Church of God. Thank you all for being here. God Bless, Fr. Dan
