Bishop Lucia has granted a dispensation from the obligation to abstain from meat on Friday, March 17, St. Patrick's Day

**Days of Abstinence**: No meat can be eaten on Fridays during Lent. This applies to all Catholics 14 and older. **Days to Fast**: Only one full meal is permitted on Good Friday for Catholics between 18 and 59. Two smaller meals are permitted, but the small meals should not equal a second full meal. Drinking coffee, tea and water between meals is allowed. Snacks between meals are not allowed.

One is not bound to fast if health or the ability to work is affected.
