Dear Parish Family,

Most people view Lent as a penitential season, which it is, but it is so much more! It is not just about 'giving up

something' or 'sacrificing something', it is about growing in our honesty with ourselves and deepening our relationship with God and the Church. As we move through this season we should be filled with a great joy and hope. Joy that our God offers to us: the gift of true freedom and unconditional love. Hope, that in Jesus our sins can be forgiven, and we can be restored to our Baptismal dignity of being a daughter or son of God. When we are at Mass and the consecrated Host is elevated, the priest proclaims: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him who takes away the sins of the world.
