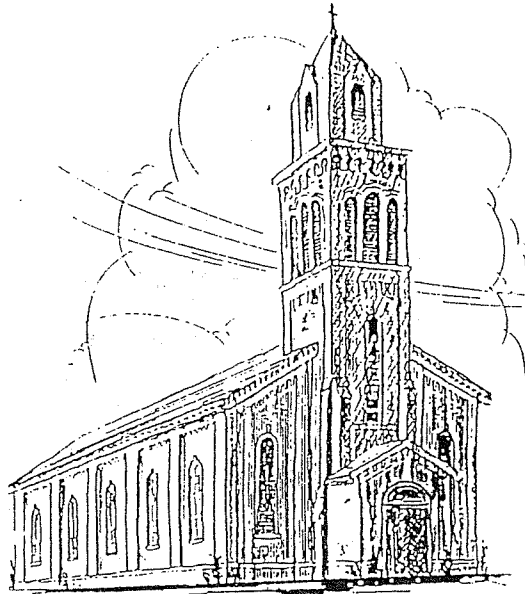

## EASTER

Dear Parish Family,  
*Thank you to everyone who was so kind to me this past week when I was sick. Those who stepped up to help with the liturgies, those who sent me food, those who helped with Honey.*

As we celebrate Easter, I thought it would be good to reflect on what Easter really means. Yes, it is the time for the new birth of spring, a time when families and friends get together, a time for new outfits, egg hunts, and baskets of candy. But the truth of Easter is so much more profound! Easter is the culmination of our entire church liturgical year and the pinnacle of Holy Week. We have celebrated Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, the gift of the Eucharist and institution of the Priesthood on Holy Thursday, Jesus' Passion and Death of Good Friday and on Easter we celebrate Jesus' glorious resurrection. Easter is the essence of our entire Christian faith. Jesus died for us, for our redemption and deliverance from sin and death and chose to remain with us in a tangible real way through the gift of His Body and Blood in the Eucharist; yet none of this would have any credibility or true value if indeed Jesus Christ had not Risen. Jesus was truly executed in a most horrific way on the cross, the soldier thrust the lance in His side and Pilate, after receiving assurance from the Tribune that Jesus was dead, allowed His disciples to remove His body from the cross and place it in a sealed tomb. On the third day after His death, when the women went to the tomb, the stone was rolled back and the tomb was empty. The Risen Lord Jesus appears multiple times after His resurrection to His disciples and Apostles; ate with them, spoke with them and even has Thomas place his hands and fingers into the nail wounds in His hands and place his hand into the lance wound in His side. This is what Easter is: JESUS WAS TRULY DEAD AND IS TRULY RISEN. Have a happy and blessed Easter! God Bless, Fr. Dan
