The Forty Days of Lent

Dear Parish Family, Lent began last Wednesday with the giving of Ashes. Why Ashes? Why forty days? Traditionally the Ashes are made by

burning the Palms from last year's Palm Sunday, this gives a connection with the whole cycle of Salvation history. The Ashes placed on our foreheads are a reminder of our human condition: our limited time on this earth and our call to humility and repentance so that we can be welcomed into our Father's Eternal Kingdom. That prayer used for the placing of the Ashes is 'Repent and believe the Good News.' Repent, turn from sin and turn toward God. Believe the Good News: in Jesus Christ's Passion, Death, and Glorious Resurrection we have been given the grace and opportunity to have our sins forgiven and be restored to the life of grace that is our Father's intention for us so that we can be with our God for all eternity in His Eternal Kingdom. Forty days are reminiscent of the forty days Jesus spent in the desert as well as the forty years the people of Israel were in the desert after the Exodus from Egypt before entering the promised land. It is important to know the forty may not be the literal number of days of Jesus in the desert or the People of Israel in the desert. In many ancient languages and cultures numbers were interchanged with letters (consider Roman numerals) and numbers expressed other realities: 40 indicated a long period of time, seven was used to indicate completion and three was used to represent perfection. The exact amount of time is not the important reality of Lent; nor is the external expression of the Ashes. Lent is a time given to focus on our internal disposition to which our external acts are to bear witness. We are called to be open and honest in our understanding of our need for repentance and conversion, so that God's grace can heal and transform us so that when we come to Easter, we will more closely transformed into the image of the Resurrected Lord Jesus Christ.
