

The Forty Days of Easter

Dear Parish Family,

Easter is not just 'one and done'; not just a celebration that takes place on

Easter Sunday. The Church celebrates the Easter Season for forty days, from the Resurrection until the Ascension. Throughout these forty days we proclaim the Gospels and New Testament readings about Jesus' appearance to the disciples after the Resurrection. During these appearances Iesus makes it very clear that He is not a ghost, an apparition, or a figment of their imagination. He is truly alive in His physical, yet glorified body. Jesus asks Thomas to touch His hands and side and experience the wounds of the Crucifixion. Jesus spends time eating with and teaching the disciples what it means for Him to be truly alive and how this message will change the course of human history. When He Ascends, they are prepared to acknowledge the truth of His Crucifixion and Resurrection, and with the coming of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost, the Church is born and empowered to proclaim boldly, despite persecution and attempts to stop the Gospel the truth: Jesus Christ is Risen and in His name, and only in His name, do we have access to the Father and can receive forgiveness, true hope and the fullness of Eternal Life in His Father's Kingdom.
