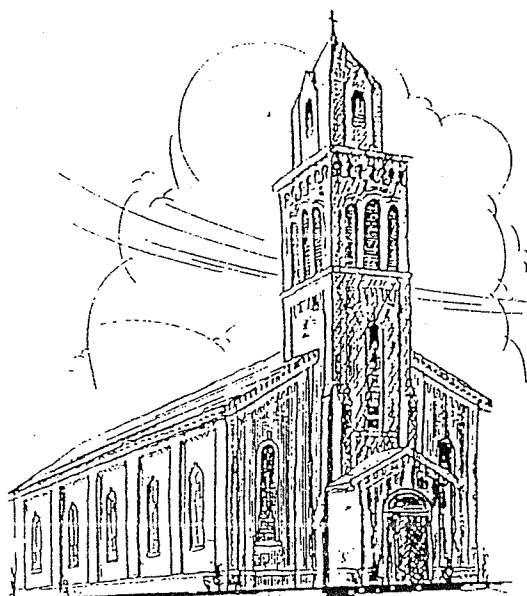

We all know that we celebrate Mother's Day on the first Sunday of May; May is also the month dedicated in a very particular way to our Blessed
