

## The Most Holy Trinity

Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity.

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church "the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian life and faith. It is the mystery of God in himself. ..." The whole history of salvation is identical to the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men and reconciles and unites with himself those who run away from sin." (234). When we pray the Creed at Mass, we reiterate our faith in God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and proclaim our faith in God's actions throughout Salvation history: Father-Creator, Son-Redeemer, Holy Spirit-Sanctifier. Yet in our limited ability to comprehend and understand the fullness of God's being, love and mercy we must also always proclaim that what is believed of the Father is also true of the Son and Holy Spirit, what is believed of the Son is also true of the Father and Holy Spirit; and what is believed of the Holy Spirit is also believed of the Father and the Son. A great mystery of our God's love for us is that, by the gift of His grace we are invited to know (to the extent of our limited intellect and reason), love (as He gives to us the ability to love), and serve Him (in accord with the graces given our individual station and vocation) and be eternally happy with God in Heaven. The Most Holy Trinity is a mystery of love and mercy of God for us. God Bless, Fr. Dan

### A Family Perspective by Bud Ozar:

The words of Jesus in today's gospel, "I have many things to say to you, but you cannot hear them now," could have been said by any parent. It can be frustrating because our desire to guide is often misinterpreted or poorly received. We cannot program our children. We can only teach, lead and trust the Spirit of truth will guide them.

## IT TAKES A MAN

### It takes a man to be a father:

to discipline his child through the inner life of the spirit rather than by the brute force of his hand;

to listen and to share his time and energy even when he is weary or busy with his own interests;

to be sensitive to his child's needs and pain rather than concerned with his own image and ego;

to be able to admit a mistake or a failure and ask forgiveness and understanding;

to be patient, honest, open, while acknowledging his own impatience, prejudices, frustrations and the anger and pain of knowing he is less than what he wants to be;

to take his child into his arms with a loving embrace when broken relationships need to be healed;

to love his child's spontaneity, just as he or she is, rather than demand predetermined and patterned responses;

to celebrate with his child the spirit of God as they together find it in the beauty of dawn, the breeze caressing their faces, the exhilaration of running, the touch of a hand, the quiet glow of shared love;

to see in the child the man or woman the child will become and be grateful for the opportunity to share in the growing up.

**It takes a man to be himself – that he may be as a father to his child, and that his child may be a child to him.**
