Dear Parish Family, <u>'Credo Quid Quid Filius Dei Dixit''</u> (I believe whatever the Son of God said.)

The past Monday I attended the funeral mass for Msgr. Yennock. Msgr. was a priest of 73 years and lived to be 97. He was my high school principal, and I had the distinct honor of being one of his honorary pall bearers. Fr. Celentano (a young priest who was ordained from St. Daniel parish) gave an excellent homily at the mass. Msgr. had given Fr. Celentano his chalice, and around the rim of the chalice was written the Latin inscription: "Credo Quid Quid Filius Dei Dixit." It struck me that to do whatever the son of God said, not only advice for a priest, but for anyone and everyone who is a Christian. This past Sunday our new group of young families met with their children for the first time. There were five families and a wonderful group of children. The children played, the parents talked, and everyone enjoyed pizza and vegetables. At whatever stage of life we are in, whatever is happening in our lives, whatever our vocation may be, to believe what the Son of God said should be the hallmark of all of our lives.
