## The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

Dear parish family,

This Solemnity celebrates another central mystery of our Catholic Faith. We believe that on the authority of Christ, by the power of the Holy Spirit acting though the office of the priest; the bread and wine at Mass become actually, literally and completely the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, the second Person of the Most Blessed Trinity. The Eucharist (the word means thanksgiving) is not a symbol of Jesus, not a sign of Jesus, not simply a memorial or remembrance; it is the real actual presence of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Host is not a blessed, or holy object: it is really our Lord and Savior, the Divine (and human) second Person of the Trinity. We read in the Gospel: Matthew 26: 26-30; Mark 14: 22-26; Luke 22: 14 - 20; and we find an account of the institution of the Eucharist and the tradition of the early Church in the celebration of the Eucharist in St. Paul's First letter to the Corinthians 11: 23-26. As we read in John's Gospel 6:51, 54, 66 (Jesus said )" I am the Living bread that came down from heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever,... he who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and... abides in me and I in him"

The Catechism of the Catholic Church proclaims: We must therefore consider the Eucharist as: - thanksgiving and praise to the Father; - sacrificial memorial of Christ and is Body; - the presence of Christ by the power of His word and of His Spirit.

When we receive Communion under either species; The Consecrated Bread and/or the Consecrated Wine; we receive the fullness of the Real Presence of Christ without prejudice or distinction.
