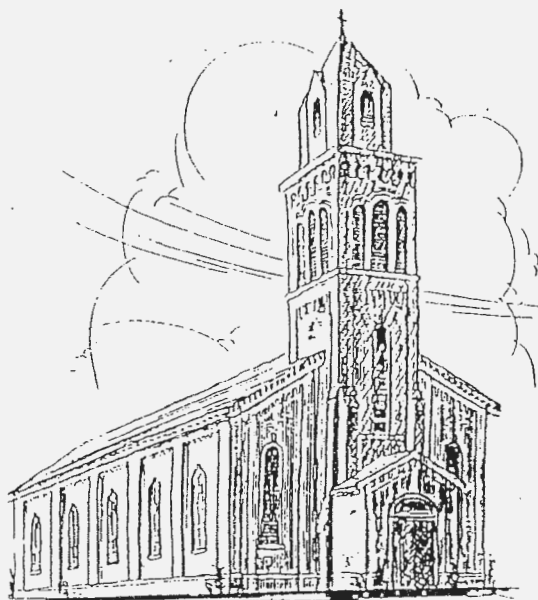

Information Regarding Mass - Parishes are no longer required to pre-register for Mass. Fully vaccinated parishioners are not required to wear a face mask. Those who are not fully vaccinated should observe social distancing of six feet from individuals not in their household. They are to wear a face mask at Mass. Even if fully vaccinated, social distancing from those who are wearing a mask is requested.

On June 6, 2021 Bishop Lucia discontinued the dispensation from Saturday Vigil or Sunday Mass in the Diocese of Syracuse and asked the Catholic Faithful to resume their full and active participation in the Eucharistic liturgy. However, those who are frail or at risk are always excused from this obligation.
