





### Dear Parish Family, The Church Militant

The church has been described according to three phases of her existence: The Church

Triumphant, those who have already entered into the Glory of Heaven; the Church Purgative, those in Purgatory who are assured of the Glory of Heaven; and we, the Church Militant, who are still on our pilgrim way. I believe that the description Church Militant is an apt description of the Church in the world today. Since the very beginning, the Church has encountered resistance, hatred, and even violence against Her and the Message of the Gospel. Our history is filled with the valiant accounts of Martyrs who would not abandon their faith to save their life. Today the church is still being attacked, sometimes subtly in the media and popular culture. Sometimes (and more and more) openly and in the perverse, disgusting, and blasphemous actions in Los Angeles and other places. Yet, we should not be surprised. We are, and always have been, in a spiritual warfare. There are forces that hate the church because she proclaims without waiver the Truth of the Gospel of Jesus and the Kingdom of God.

Jesus did speak of this in the Gospel: "Blessed are you when men revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil falsely on my account. Rejoice and be glad for your reward is great in heaven, for so men persecuted the prophets who were before you." (Matthew 5:11). Jesus also said: "In the world you have tribulation but be of good cheer. I have overcome the world." (John 16:33).

So, how should we respond and react? As always recognize that the battle is not only ours. The Holy Spirit is on our side as are all the Holy Saints and Angels of God. We should never despair or give up. We should continue proclaiming and living the Truth, continue in prayer, continue celebrating the Sacraments, and remember that Jesus promised to be with us until the end of time and that: "the powers of Hell shall not prevail against the Church" (Matthew 16:19). We continue to live in faith, hope and love, knowing that Our God is always with us, and He cannot be stopped.
