Dear parish family,
The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines Pentecost in this way:
"The fiftieth day at the end of the seven weeks following Passover (Easter in the Christian dispensation). At the first Pentecost after the Resurrection and Ascension of Jesus, the Holy Spirit was manifested, given and communicated as a Divine Person to the Church, fulfilling the Paschal mystery of Christ according to His promise. Annually the Church celebrates the memory of Pentecost as the beginning of the "new age of the church," when Christ lives and acts in and with His Church."
The fruits of the Holy Spirit are: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.
The gifts of the Holy Spirit that are given at Confirmation are: wisdom, understanding, knowledge, right judgment, courage, reverence, holy fear in God's presence.
As we celebrate Pentecost this year we pray: "Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful and enkindle in them the fire of Your love.
