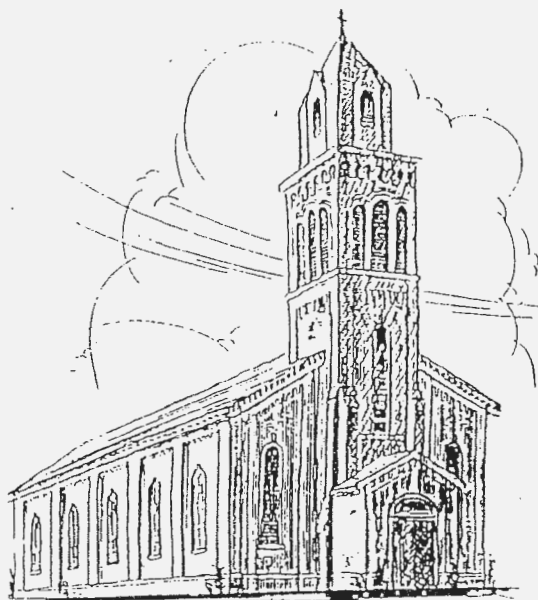

Information Regarding Mass

Mass: Parishes are no longer required to pre-register for Mass. Parishioners who are fully vaccinated are not required to wear a face mask at Mass. All who prefer to continue wearing facial covering and social distancing are free to do so. Those who are not fully vaccinated should observe social distancing of six feet from individuals not in their household. They are to wear a face mask at Mass. Even if fully vaccinated, social distancing from those who are wearing a mask is requested.

Bishop Lucia will discontinue in the Diocese of Syracuse the dispensation from Sunday Mass beginning on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ on Sunday, June 6th. Anyone who is frail or at risk due to advanced age or medical conditions is always excused from this obligation. Caregivers, too, may have to use prudential judgment about attendance.
