## The Reality of Evil

Dear Parish Family, One of the subjects that most people, and especially in our society, have avoided, or tried to discredit is that there is evil in our world, and that we humans are capable of evil. In an environment where nothing is wrong, everything is acceptable, all truth is subjective, that we can do nothing wrong, then there can be no evil, no wrong, and therefore no accountability. In our Catholic faith tradition, we do recognize the existence of evil. There is physical evil, those naturally occurring events (such as tornadoes, earthquakes, etc.) that we perceive as evil because of the bad effects they have on human life and/or property. Moral evil. or sin, is the direct result of human free will choices to disobey God and His Truth. Then there is the Demonic or Satan and the evil spirits. Most people have dismissed Satan and the demonic as myth or remnants from a past that was less enlightened than the modern world; yet look around, the evidence for the Demonic is everywhere. One of Satan's greatest tools is to deny his existence.

Our Scripture readings speak of Satan both in Genesis and the Gospel. The word Satan means adversary' from the Hebrew root word meaning 'plot against.' Since the beginning, Satan and the demonic have plotted against humankind to take them away from the Kingdom of God and destroy our relationship with God, His creation, and our true self.

The opposite of adversary is advocate; this is another title for the Holy Spirit. The fruits of the Holy Spirit are charity, joy, peace. patience, goodness, generosity, gentleness, modesty, self-control, and chastity. It's obvious that the opposite fruits are in play in the world in which we live: selfishness, sadness, alienation, corruption and crime, in-temperance, violence, hatred, discord and promiscuity and lasciviousness. The evidence is real, the struggle is real. There is a spiritual battle going on, and we have to choose which side we are on: the side of the Holy Spirit or the side of the Demonic. Which fruits dominate my life and our society. God Bless, Fr. Dan
