

The Power of Prayer

Dear Parish Family, Each weekend at Mass in the prayers of the faithful we remember the

prayers in our 'Book of Intentions,' and 'Memorial Book' and last week prayer cards for the sick were available. You may have noticed in front of the altar a box marked: "prayer intentions"; these are from the weekend of the Eucharistic Miracle presentation and the Blessed Carlos Acutius exhibit. I plan to leave this box in front of the altar until the beginning of Advent so that our parishioners (in fact anyone who wishes) may write a prayer intention and place it in the box... There is a group who gather every Thursday to pray the Rosary, and every First Friday people have the opportunity to spend an hour with the Lord in adoration. Our prayers aren't simply what we do by rote, we do believe in the power of prayer and that as Jesus tells us: "If two or three of agree on earth to pray for anything it will be granted to you by My Father in Heaven." Of course prayer is not magic, nor are our prayers magic incantations, yes, our heavenly Father answers our prayers, but not always in the way that we want. Sometimes, like any good parent, the answer must be 'no' for our own spiritual and even physical good. The most powerful prayer is the Eucharist, where we join with our Euchristic Lord in offering up all to the Father in the power of the Holy Spirit. Someone once said: "Act like everything depends on you; pray because everything depends on **God.**" There is no vacation from prayer.
