

Christian Love

Dear Parish Family,
The three Theological virtues are Faith, Hope and Love; according to St. Paul, Love is the greatest and the

foundation upon which the Christian Life is based. In Corinthians, Paul writes: "Love is patient, love is kind, it is not jealous, it is not pompous, it is not inflated, it is not rude, it does not seek its own interests, it is not quick-tempered, it does not brood over injury, it does not rejoice over wrongdoing but rejoices in the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails." (1 Corinthians 13: 1-13)

This virtue is the very essence of God, as God is described as Love. This is not the love of the world: it is something very different. The love of God is freeing and sets free; it is forgiving and creative. However, it is not the same as liking. Liking is an emotion, based on attraction, or similar interests and goals. The Love of God is a decision based on 'grace'; to look beyond any external, or changing reality, or deed that a person has done to find a unique child of God, created in the Divine Image and redeemed by the Blood of Christ. This Love reminds us that we are to love as we have been loved by God: freely, honestly, without any condition or reservation.

Cell phones, emails, faxes, texts and voicemails can reduce our lives to a continual series of interrupted moments. Listen to Jesus in today's gospel: "You are anxious about many things" robbing us of the precious time needed to BE with others. Quality time is QUANTITY time.

Question of the Week - Holy Visitors

For Adults: Which response to God's call is more natural to you—prayer or action? Why?

For Children: In the past week, when have you prayed and when have you done good things for others? Which could you do better?

World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly: July 27, 2025 (September 6-7, 2025 for the US)

Theme: "Blessed are those who have not lost hope" (cf. Sir 14:2)

This day is intended to encourage us to reflect on how the presence of our grandparents and the elderly can be a sign of hope in our families and church community.

Here are some ideas of how to celebrate:

1. Host a Mass of Thanksgiving and invite grandparents to take part.
2. Have a Grandparents' Book of Remembrance to remember parishioners' grandparents who are no longer with us at each Mass that weekend.
3. Host a novena and/or holy hour for grandparents and the elderly.
4. Forget-me-not flowers are the official flowers for grandparents. These might be included in the liturgy or seeds might be passed on to grandchildren to grow in memory of their grandparents.
