

### Dear Parish Family, Who do you say that I am?

This question was put to Peter: ".... He (Jesus) asked his disciples, 'Who do people

say that the Son of Man is?" They responded: "Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." He said to them: "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter said in reply, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."

For anyone who professes to be a Christian, a Disciple of Jesus, this is the most important question. A Rabbi friend of mine told me that Jews could accept Jews as a Rabbi, a moral teacher, one among many Rabbis in the history of Israel, Islam accepts Jesus as a prophet in the longline of prophets. But for we Chritians, Jesus is not just another good person, or moral teacher, or even a prophet. He is truly Christ, the Son of the Living God, and as such He, and only He holds the words of eternal life, for He is the way and the Truth and the Life. Jesus is God.

So, take time to ask yourself: "Who do I say that Jesus Is?" Hopefully you will acknowledge Him as your personal Lord and Savior.
