

## *The Sign of the Cross*

Dear Parish Family,

Did you ever notice that most Protestant Churches use the Cross instead of the Crucifix; which is used

in Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox Churches? The Crucifix has the corpus of the Crucified Lord on it, while a Cross usually does not. When Roman Catholics make the 'sign of the Cross'; in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, as we begin our prayers, we make the sign of the Cross from forehead to the abdomen, to the left shoulder and then to the right. Eastern Orthodox Catholics make the sign of the Cross from the forehead, to the abdomen, to the right shoulder and then to the left. As we enter the Church we bless ourselves with the sign of the Cross using Holy Water (which is a Sacramental) and a reminder of our Baptism (this is sometimes referred to the blessing of the 'pre-sanctified' before we approach to receive the Holy Eucharist. At the end of Mass, we are blessed with the sign of the Cross: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." When we begin and end our personal and/or devotional prayers, we also do the Sign of the Cross. Why do we use the crucifix and the sign of the Cross as Catholics? We do so as a reminder of the Sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross, the price of our Salvation and the gift of our Redemption. The next time you bless yourself as you enter Mass, or begin your personal or family prayer, stop and take a moment to realize and appreciate why we do this. God Bless, Fr. Dan
