

#### Dear Parish Family,

"There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who

produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit." (1 Cor. 4-7)

Usually when we hear the phrase: "Pray for Vocations"; we automatically think of the Priesthood; while Priesthood is indeed one of the elements of Holy Orders, there are other vocations within the Church. A vocation is an invitation from God to live a life according to His plan for the person's happiness, salvation, and service to the Church. All vocations spring from our Baptism and all vocations are invitations to holiness and ministry. Holy Orders consist of Bishop. Priest, and Deacon. The Bishop is the head of the Diocese and the chief teacher of the Diocese. The word Bishop comes from the word for 'overseer'. The priest assists the Bishop, usually within a specific parish. The word priest implies one who offers sacrifice. The Deacon provides the Church's public ministry of service. There are those who are called to the vocation of religious/consecrated life to which I made reference in last week's bulletin. Matrimony is a vocation for a man and women to live in a permanent, graced filled union with a twofold purpose; the communion of life and love between the spouses and the bringing forth of the new life of children. This vocation gives witness to the union of Christ with His spouse, the Church and the loving creative power of our God. The vocation to live as a single person is a call to give public witness to God in the world in a state of life that offers a unique opportunity in the world to proclaim by word and deed in the secular arena of the redemptive love of God in Jesus Christ. Each vocation is an essential element of the Body of Christ, and each helps us get a glimpse of the love and wonder of God!
