Dear Parish Family,

This weekend we celebrate Catechetical Sunday, a time when we remember and thank God for two of our greatest gifts: the gift of our faith,

and the gift of our children. It is important for us, as a faith family, to ensure that the next generation shares our faith and our values. While it is true that the family is the first school of faith for children, the faith family also has a commitment to and responsibility for passing on faith. In our Faith Formation program our children learn about God's love and mercy, what it means to be a Catholic Christian, the Ten Commandments, Our Blessed Mother and the Saints, who God is, and how the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are active parts of each baptized person's life. The classes are at age-appropriate levels - beginning with first grade, up to and including Confirmation in High School. The students learn about the importance of Christian service and the Sacramental life. In First Penance and First Communion classes, the children are helped to understand responsibility for their actions, how to ask for and receive God's forgiveness in Confession and about the wonderful gift that is the Eucharist. As young men and women in Confirmation, they are taught how to make moral decisions, more about the Scripture, the Church and what it means to be an adult missionary disciple in the Catholic Church.

Each year we are in need of catechists (teachers), aids and other adults to help. You do not have to be a theologian to teach. We provide the necessary materials and support; what one needs is a love of our Faith and a love of our children. Everyone can do something to teach and support those necessary ministries, so that our children, who are bombarded with values of a society that is NOT in accord with the values of our Catholic Faith, will grow up with our faith and our moral values.

You can help, and I believe each adult SHOULD help, and educate the next generation of our faith.


