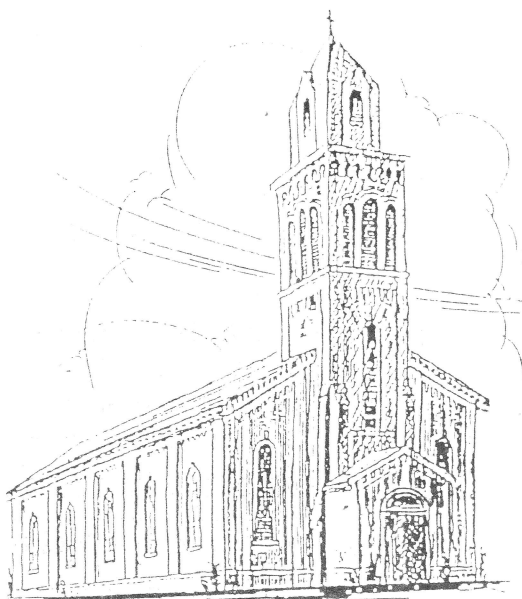

Dear parish family,
Last week we looked at the time to re-evaluate our relationship with God. It is also important to look at our Christian relationship to the Church and the larger world.

The Church has **Five Precepts** to help us look at our relationship with the Church:

1. Attend Mass on Sundays and Holy days of obligation and to rest from servile labor.
2. Confess our sins once a year.
3. Receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter Season.
4. Observe days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
5. Provide for the needs of the Church.

Give drink to the thirsty
Clothe the naked
Visit the imprisoned
Shelter the homeless
Visit the sick
Bury the dead

Admonish sinners
Comfort the afflicted
Forgive offenses
Bear wrongs patiently
Pray for the living and the dead
