A Note from Fr. Dan

What do Catholics believe?

Dear Parish Family,

Over the next few weeks I will discuss some fundamental beliefs of the Catholic Church; many people do not understand the Eucharistic teachings of the Roman Catholic Church.

Our most fundamental teaching is what we practice, teach and believe about the Holy Eucharist. We practice, teach and believe that during the Eucharistic activity, by the power of the Holy Spirit at the words of consecration the bread and wine become actually, literally, the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ, the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity. We call this the Dogma of the Real Presence. The Eucharist is not a symbol of Jesus, a simple remembrance of Jesus, a sign of Jesus; it is not a thing but rather the Divine Person of Jesus Christ. Since the earliest days of the Christian community, before the turn of the first century AD, this was the practice, teaching and belief of the Christian Church. The Eucharist is the summit of all that we, as Catholics believe and hold to be true. All of the early Church Fathers held this to be true, and necessary for participation in The Body of Christ. The Scripture gives witness to this. The words Jesus used at the Last Supper are very clear: 'Now as they were eating, Jesus took some bread, and when he had said the blessing he broke it and gave it to his disciples. 'Take and eat, he said 'this is my body. Then he took a cup, and when returned thanks he gave it to them. 'Drink from this all of you,' he said, 'for this is my blood, the blood of the new covenant which is to be poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.' (MT 26:26-29 see also Mk 14:22-25, Lk 22:19-20.

We read in the Gospel of John 6:52-57. (Jesus said) "I tell you solemnly, if you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood you will not have life in you. Anyone who does eat my flesh and drink my blood has eternal life and I shall raise him up on the last day. For my flesh is real food and my blood real drink, He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood lives in me and I live in him"

Next week we will look at the concept of transubstantiation. God bless,
