



A Note from Fr. Dan

Oh Antiphons

.The “O Antiphons”

The order of the prayers is significant.

Starting with the last title in reverse order, the first letter of each (Emmanuel, Rex, Oriens, Clavis, Radix, Adonai, Sapientia) forms an acrostic: the Latin words Ero cras, which speak Jesus’ response and promise to us. “Tomorrow, I will come.”

17 December: O Sapientia (O Wisdom)

18 December: O Adonai

19 December: O Radix Jesse (O Root of Jesse)

20 December: O Clavis David (O Key of David)

21 December: O Oriens (O Dawn of the East)

22 December: O Rex Gentium (O King of the Nations)

23 December: O Emmanuel

These are called the Great O Antiphons and are used during evening prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours that priests, deacons, religious and some lay people pray daily. The last seven days leading up to Christmas have special liturgical celebrations of the Mass and the Liturgy of the hours.

God bless as we draw close to the Celebration of the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ.
