A Note from Fr. Dan

The teaching of the Catholic Church

Dear Parishioners,

The Church's understanding of the office of the papacy (the Pope) is very important to understand. The hierarchical nature of the Roman Catholic Church. From St. Peter to Pope Leo IV, is a direct line of succession. There have been 266 Popes. The Pope has many titles: Bishop of Rome, Successor to St. Peter, Vicar of Christ on Earth, Patriarch of the West, Supreme Pontiff of the Universal Church, and Servant of the Servants of God. As early as the 1st Century AD. St. Irenaeus described the Bishop of Rome as the First among equals. Since then the Bishop of Rome has held the place of prominence in the Catholic Church. It was to St. Peter that Jesus gave the Keys of the Kingdom of God, that is why keys are depicted on the Papal flag . The office of the Papacy has universal jurisdiction (governing authority over the Church) and universal magisterium (teaching authority over the entire Church. There is a Latin saying: "Roma locuta est, cause finita est" when Rome speaks, the case is closed. The office of the Papacy (the Pope) also has the Charism of Infallibility. This was solemnly defined as Dogma (a teaching that Catholics are bound to accept in faith). At the First Vatican Council, (1869-1879) in the document 'Pastor Aeternus', 'Eternal Pastor'. Not every utterance or teaching of the Pope is Infallible, however when the Pope teaches with the three conditions: It must be a matter of Faith and/ or morals; it must be 'Ex Cathedra' that is clear that the Pope is exercising His authority as Supreme Teacher of the Universal Church; and it must be made public than we have an Infallible teaching. Because of the seriousness and importance of Infallible Teaching, these are done very carefully and very rarely proclaimed (the exception being the declaring of someone to be a Saint, which are Infallible teachings.) An example would be the Dogma of the Immaculate conception, proclaimed December 8, 1854. In addition to being the spiritual father of the approximately 1 billion Roman Catholics worldwide; the Pope is also the head of Vatican City state which is in Rome, but independent of the Italian government. The Vatican City State is 5,274 sq.ft; with its own government, flag, stamps and the Swiss Guard.
